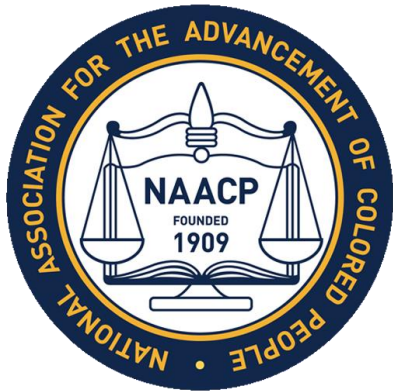




The Alabama NAACP

The Alabama State Conference of the NAACP will select 10-20 applicants to participate in a year-long program to train Alabama Young Adults on the functions of the NAACP and develop their leadership skills while pursuing their careers, families and community service. It will consist of online and in person meetings that will include food as well as a

travel stipend for those traveling long distances to each meeting place. Upon completion participants will be knowledgeable on the NAACP, equipped with the necessary skills and lessons to grow further in their careers and be consistent leaders and contributors to their communities. The top performer will also receive a Silver Lifetime Membership in the NAACP.
